

ICRICT welcomes the adoption of the Terms of Reference for a UN Tax Convention.

August, 18 2024. In a landmark decision, a vote at the United Nations (UN) on August 16 affirmed the will of a majority of countries to move forwards towards building a new international tax system based on fairness and inclusiveness.

The majority vote in favour of the Terms of Reference (ToRs) for a United Nations Framework Convention on International Tax Cooperation demonstrates a firm commitment to effectively combatting tax abuse by multinational corporations and high net-worth individuals, making sure they pay their fair share.

ICRICT welcomes this vote which advances international tax cooperation in an inclusive and sustainable manner.
